# CPC31020 - Certificate III in Solid Plastering



## Description

This qualification reflects the role of solid plasterers working in the building and construction industry. Individuals applying plaster finishes to internal and external surfaces of residential and commercial buildings.

## Course Duration

This course has been designed to be delivered over **52 weeks** of scheduled classes, including 10 weeks of holiday periods.

Students are required to attend 20 scheduled course contact hours per week.

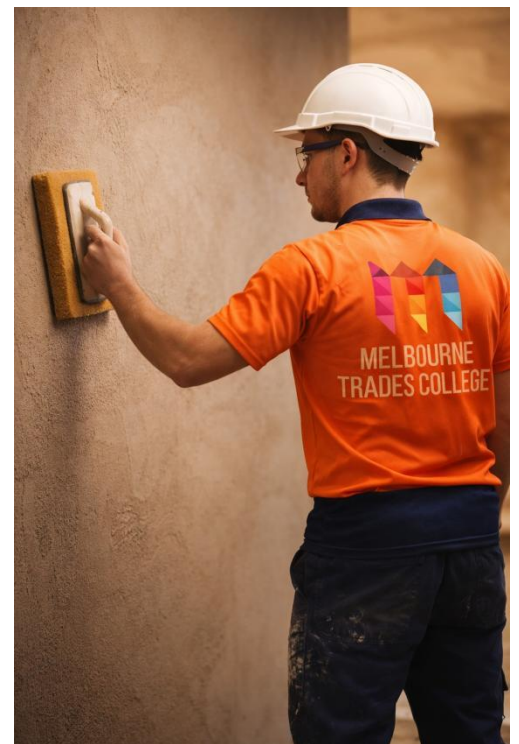

## General Entry requirements:

- Applicants must be **18 years of age or older**
- Satisfactory completion of **Australian Year 11** or equivalent
- Minimum **IELTS score of 6** or PTE equivalent (for international students)
- Successful completion of a Pre-Training Review
- Successful completion of an LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) test
- Physical capability suitable for working in construction, including manual handling and working at heights



## Who can Enrol

International students who may have limited knowledge or some experience in the Construction industry. It is expected that their knowledge and skills will be developed over the duration of the course.

## Mode of Delivery

- Classroom based Face to Face theory learning
- Practical training at Construction workshop

Students exiting the qualification may choose to progress with further studies by undertaking one or more of the following qualifications:

- CPC40120 Certificate IV in Building and Construction

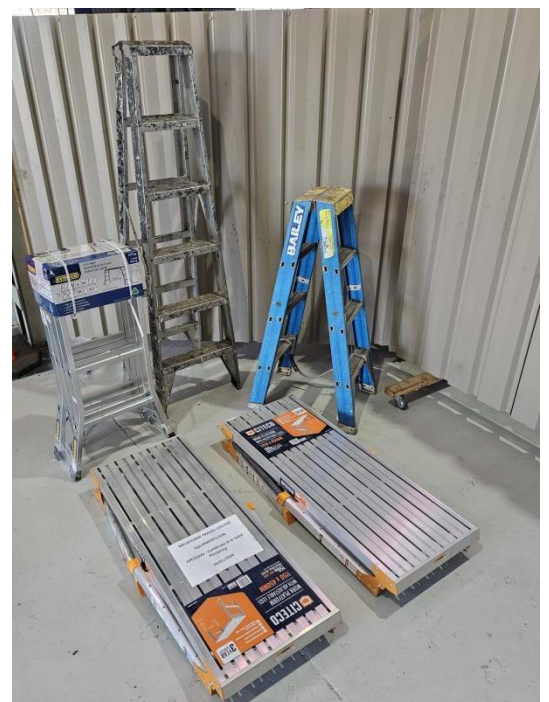
## Assessments
